



PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

1. CONDUCT

- a) Play fairly and by the rules. Be a good sport and applaud good play on both your team and the opposition.
- b) Control your temper, verbal abuse of officials or other players, is not acceptable.
- c) Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain approach the official during a break or after competition.
- d) Work equally hard for yourself and your team and co-operate with your coach. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- e) Treat all players as you would like treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- f) Respect your coach. Turn up to scheduled training sessions and be on time. If you are unable to attend any training sessions or game then give your coach an appropriate amount of time to make alternate arrangements.
- g) Come to training prepared in the appropriate attire. Suitable clothing should be worn at all times for training. Fashion shoes (Vans etc), singlets/crop tops, denim shorts are all inappropriate for training sessions) Players should be wearing shoulder covering t-shirts, shorts or leggings and proper running shoes to all training sessions.

2. NON NEGOTIABLES

The TTGNC will not tolerate any actions such as assault, Verbal Abuse, Bullying, Physical Abuse, Any form of Harassment or deliberate misconduct by any player, parent, spectator or official of our club.
