



## **PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT**

This Code of Conduct has been developed by the TTGNC Committee and should apply to all players at TTGNC while associated with any of the TTNC activities. It outlines the standard of behaviour expected from players, and is intended to ensure a safe, fair and enjoyable environment within the netball community.

### **1 CONDUCT**

1.1 Play fairly and by the rules. Be a good sport and applaud good play on both your team and the opposition.

1.2 Work equally hard for yourself and your team and co-operate with your coach. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.

1.3 Control your temper, Verbal Abuse or deliberately provoking with officials, other players/spectators or coach is not acceptable and will not be tolerated by TTGNC.

1.4 Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain approach the official during a break or after competition

1.5 Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take advantage of another player.

1.6 Respect your coach. Turn up to scheduled training sessions and be on time. If you are unable to attend any training sessions or games, then give your coach an appropriate amount of time to make alternative arrangements.

1.7 Come to training in compulsory training top, shorts/leggings and proper running shoes ( singlets/cropped tops, vans and denim shorts are NOT acceptable). Correct uniform for all matches.

### **2 NON NEGOTIABLES**

The TTGNC is committed to maintaining a safe physical and emotional environment for our officials, registered players, umpires, coaches, parents, spectators and sponsors. TTGNC has an obligation to help facilitate anti-social, inappropriate, and even illegal behaviour and activities that can occur via ICT devices/equipment. "Cyberbullying" will not be tolerated by our club. Cyberbullying includes, but is not limited to, the following misuses of technology: harassing, teasing, intimidating, racially vilifying or threatening another person by sending or posting inappropriate and hurtful e-mail messages, instant messages, text or phone



messages, digital pictures/images, or WEB Site postings (including social network sites IE Face Book or blogs).

Nor will TTGNC tolerate any actions such assault, Verbal/Physical/Sexual Abuse, Bullying and any form of Harassment or deliberate misconduct.

The General Committee when necessary, will take appropriate action against any persons who places the health, safety and wellbeing of another person at risk, including referring the matter to relevant Statutory Authorities and /or expulsion from the CLUB.
