



UMPIRES CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct has been developed by the TTGNC General Committee and should apply to all Umpires at TTGNC while associated with any of the TTNC activities. It outlines the standard of behaviour expected from Umpires, and is intended to ensure a safe, fair and enjoyable environment within the netball community.

1. CONDUCT

1. Umpires will consistently apply rules and regulations to match the skill levels and needs of young people and to make participation more fun.
2. Treat all players, coaches, match officials and other umpires with respect and adhere to TTGNC policies and SADNA mandated responsibility when it comes to Child Safety. Umpires will condemn unsporting behaviour and promote respect equally for all opponents.
4. Use approved umpires' uniform – full white attire and use recommended equipment such as the Thunderball Whistle.
5. Be consistent and objective when making decisions.
6. Always maintain a high standard of personal behaviour. Including being a positive role model through behaviour and personal appearance projecting a favourable image of netball and umpiring always.
7. Umpires are expected to keep up to date with umpire practices and qualifications.
8. Umpires must obtain a current Working with Children Accredited Check.

2. GRIEVANCES

If you feel you have been treated unfairly, you have the right to lodge a grievance.

2.1 – During a game you can ask the coach, or you can ring SADNA Office 8251 5211 and ask for umpire official to observe the game. If it is a serious matter you can complete and lodge with SADNA an Incident Report within 48hours of game.
